Annual Report Session 2019-2020

The college offers undergraduate courses in Arts, Commerce & Science and skill based courses B.Voc., BBA, BCA & PG Courses in English, Economics, Political Science.

Enrollment : For the session 2019-20, total enrollment of students is 5093 out of which no. of boys is 2440 & that of girls is 2653.

Transfers, Vacancies and Superannuation : During the session 2019-20, ten members of teaching staff joined this college, nine were transferred to other colleges and one fresh appointment was made. In the non teaching staff six members joined and six got transferred and one got promoted to the post of SLA. One fresh appointment was also made. There are two vacant positions as teaching faculty - one in Dept. of Commerce and one in Dept. of History. There are five vacancies in the non teaching staff viz Senior Assistant - 1, JLA – 2 and RA – 2. This year, Smt. Maya Devi superannuated from the post of peon.

Developmental Work : Various developmental activities were carried out during the session. The installation of solar panels connected to power grid is being undertaken for which RUSA fund was allotted last year. Wooden shelves fixation, Aquaguard and washbasin installation was done and water and electricity connections were given in the cabin adjacent to the stage in the multipurpose hall. Repair of sewage line and fixing of window iron grills in New Arts Block, fencing work near parking and boys’ toilet, repair of e-podiums and corridor benches was done. In Boys hostel, fencing, repair work of toilets, bathrooms, electric and water connections were done. In the Botany Dept., Digital Microscope and Incubators were purchased and Aquaguard was installed.

It is a matter of great happiness that by the initiative of our Honourable Minister Sh. Govind Singh Thakur our college has been provided Kabaddi Mats from the Directorate of Youth Services and Sports HP. Sh. Govind Singh Thakur has also been generous in sanctioning the expenses to be incurred on the construction of Basket Ball Court in our college campus. We have also received a grant of Fifty Thousand Rupees for promotion of sports and cultural activities in the college.

Scholarships

Scholarships are given to the eligible students under various central and state sponsored schemes. This year the process is still in progress.

P.T.A. : Parent Teacher Association has always been participating actively in the overall development and other welfare activities of the college. The PTA fund is used to meet out the salaries of the guest faculty and non teaching staff engaged on PTA basis and developmental works and coaching for various activities. For the session 19-20, the opening balance in the PTA fund was Rs. 4,09,816. This year, the college has spent an amount of Rs. 17,58,859 out of PTA fund till now and the remaining balance as on 13th Jan 2020 is Rs. 11,82,930.

LIBRARY : The college has a well equipped library registered with NLIST programme of INFLIBNET having access to 6000 plus e-journals and 31,35,000 e-books, besides having a stock of 27,829 books. The library has regular subscription of 42 periodicals and 11 newspapers so that the students can get ample opportunity to keep abreast of current issues and prepare for various competitive examinations. An LED TV has also been installed in the library to facilitate the dissemination of knowledge through educational channels and DVDs etc. This year, Pawan Kumar of 6th Semester and Anjali of 2nd Year have been adjudged the best readers among the boys and girls respectively.

- 8 of our cadets participated in RDC selection camp.

N. S. S. : Under the leadership of Dr. Ram Singh and Prof. Anupama Katoch 159 volunteers were registered in the two units of NSS. Jaishankar of BCom 6th Sem and Miss Promila of BSc 6th Sem have been nominated as presidents (Boys/Girls) & Mr. Tushar Sharma and Ms Rooma

Devi were adjudged the best volunteers among boys & girls respectively for this session. During the whole session the NSS volunteers enthusiastically participated in various activities.

- On every Friday the volunteers conducted a cleanliness drive to clean the campus as well as spread awareness about importance of cleanliness.
- The volunteers took part in a mock drill organized by DDMA on 11th July 2019.

Rovers & Rangers : The Bharat Scouts and Guides which is a part of World Organization Scouting Movement envisioned to provide value based system, attractive and challenging youth programmes to young minds. The teachers in charge of Rovers and Rangers for the session are Sh. Jyoti Charan and Dr. Meena Chaudhary respectively. The college has enrolled 24 Rovers and 24 Rangers with Jai Singh as Rover President and Diksha Thakur as Ranger President for this session. Different groups of Rover & Ranger participated in community service Programmes like Tree plantation, Blood Donation, Cleanliness and De Addiction.

- During the Seven day International Dussehra Festival the Rovers and Rangers unit of the college sensitized the general public about the dangers of drug abuse by performing street plays on 12th Oct 2019. Four Rovers and two Rangers also helped the local police in regulating the traffic during the seven day long fair.
- On Scouts Founders Day on 7th Nov 2019 they spread awareness regarding the ill effects of drug abuse and on 14th Nov 2019 on hazards of Plastic use through a skit and a street play respectively in Govt Senior Secondary School Raison. session. The boys have always been actively participating in academic, cultural, sports, developmental and welfare activities. The hostlers have been well maintaining the plantation area having 65 plantations.

Girls' Hostel : 107 girls were enrolled in the session 2019-2020 under the warden ship of Dr. Ram Singh. Ms. Sunita was nominated the Head Girl and Ms. Preeti Bangar, Ms Deepmala and Ms Santosh were selected as the Prefects for the session. The girls also have been participating actively and representing college in various activities.

Career Counseling and Placement Cell : The Career Counseling and Guidance Cell aims to provide opportunities to the students for their career options in different fields. It organizes specialized lectures from the invited speakers, placement drives (in collaboration with District Employment Office) and also organizes interactive sessions with the representatives of different universities and educational institutions.

This year, On 7th and 8th August 2019 a program was organized by the Career Counselling Cell in which a representative from HP Kaushal Vikas Nigam apprised the students about B. Voc. various Add on courses to be started by HPKVN in different colleges of the state.

A Rozgar Mela was organized on 05 October 2019 in the Multi-purpose hall in collaboration with the District Employment Office, Kullu in which the hiring firms/companies conducted interviews for various posts. A total number of 10 students were shortlisted for various jobs.

A lecture on “The Need for Moral and Ethical Values in Career” was organized in collaboration with Chitkara University on 12 December 2019.

SELF-FINANCING COURSES : Bachelor of Computer Application and Bachelor of Business Administration Programmes being run in the college have been imparting quality and skill based education for the professional benefit of the students. Prof. Kashmir Singh and Dr. Maan Singh are the coordinators of the BCA and BBA respectively.

B. VOC. : Under the skill development programme of the H.P. Govt., the college has introduced the B. Voc. Programme in 2017 in two areas – Retail Management and Hospitality & Tourism. In compliance with the National Skill Qualification Framework, this programme is unique with the provision of multiple entries and exits at different levels thereby giving flexibility to students to study and earn as per their convenience and needs. A batch of 45 students in each area is selected in every session. Presently, Dr. Shefali is the coordinator of this course.

IGNOU : The IGNOU Centre established in the college in 1992 caters to the various academic needs of the students and provides courses ranging from certificate, diploma, graduation to post-graduation. During the session 2019-20, the number of registered students is 2362. Mrs. Seema Sharma is the coordinator of the study centre presently. 39 programs are being offered in the center and B.Sc Course has also been introduced this year.

COLLEGE MAGAZINE – DEVDHARA: Every year, the college publishes its annual magazine Devdhara to give opportunity to the students to express their creative abilities in different genres.

House Tests : Under the component of Continuous Comprehensive Assessment (CCA) the midterm tests for semester/annual system are held as per the decided norms of the HPU. Dr.

Brij Bala is presently working as Controller of Examination for the smooth conduct of these examinations.

CSCA Cultural Program – Srijan : Every year the CSCA organizes two day cultural program Srijan providing a platform to the students to show their talents in various cultural activities. This year the program was organized on 12th and 13th Mar 2020.

Educational Tour : 48 students went on an Educational Tour to Rajasthan from 30 Jan 2020 to 11th Feb 2020 under the guidance of Dr. Hiramani Kashyap, Assistant Professor in Tourism. During the tour, the students explored many parts of Rajasthan and it was a good learning experience for them. An educational field trip was organized by the Dept of Botany to familiarize the students of BSc 5th Semester with the Flora of the Western Himalayas. 68 students participated in this trip under the guidance of Dr. Harish Anand, Mrs. Monika and Mr. Rajeev Paramar.

Swachhta Abhiyan : Besides the regular cleanliness drives conducted by NSS, NCC and Rovers and Rangers volunteers, all the Departments and constituted committees conduct cleanliness drives in various blocks of the campus to promote the Swachhta Abhiyan on every Saturday.
