Central Schemes

1. CENTRAL SECTOR SCHEME OF SCHOLARSHIPS FOR COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY STUDENTS

Central Sector Scholarship – Eligibility Criteria

- The applicants must be in the top 20th percentile merit list of class 12 results of concerned boards (SEB/CBSE/ICSE).
- The candidates must be pursuing regular courses of graduation/post graduation/ professional studies from colleges/ universities recognised by AICTE, UGC, MCI, DCI or other regulatory bodies.
- The candidates belonging to reserved categories of SC, ST, OBC and PWD will get a reservation of 15%, 7.5%, 27% and 5%, respectively.
- The candidates' annual family income must not exceed INR 8 Lakh.
- The applicants must not be availing of any other scholarship benefits.
- Also, those students who are pursuing Diploma courses are not eligible for this merit-cum-means scholarship.

2. POST MATRIC SCHOLARSHIP FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

Post-Metric Scholarship for Students with Disabilities Eligibility Criteria

- The scholarship scheme is open to **Indian students only**.
- Students with more than **40 percent disability** are eligible to apply.
- The overall family annual income should not exceed **INR 2,50,000** (two lakh fifty thousand).
- The applicant must be studying in **class 11 upto post-graduate or diploma**.

- More than two persons with disability from the same family of the same parents are not encouraged to apply.
- Scholars benefiting under any other scheme are not eligible to apply.
- Employed students with family income less than that of the scholarship amount can apply for the scheme.
- Students completed one stream and studying in the same stream (e.g. BA after B.Com.) are not eligible to apply.
- The scholar must maintain regularity in attendance to avail scholarship renewal.
- The student must be successfully promoted to the next higher class.
- If a student from the Group 1 courses fails for the first time, the scholarship may be renewed and for the subsequent failure, an in-class student shall bear the expenses until he/ she promotes to the next higher class.
- If a scholar fails to appear in the final examination due to illness or any other unforeseeable situations, the scholarship renewal may be generated for the next year on the basis of submission of medical proof or other satisfactory proof.

Note: 50 percent of the total scholarships are reserved for girl students.

3. SANSKRIT SCHOLARSHIP FOR MERITORIOUS STUDENTS (SPONSIRED BY CENTRAL SANSKRIT UNIVERSITY)

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The Scholarship is awarded to those student who have obtained the minimum percentage or equivalent grade in Sanskrit/ Pali/ Prakrit and aggregate in all subjects can be applied for Scholarship: —

• General Category - 60% marks

• SC/ST/Differently abled - 50% marks

• OBC - 55% marks

 Class 9 to 12, UG, PG and Ph.D. students studying Sanskrit as a main or optional subject

- A scholarship amount of up to INR 2,500 per month.
- Students pursuing graduation/Shastri or equivalent with Sanskrit/ Pali/ Prakrit as a subject of at least 100 marks:
 - The applicants must have passed class 12/Intermediate with at least
 60% overall marks and 60% in Sanskrit/Pali/Prakrit.
 - For B.A. 1st/2nd/3rd year, the candidates must have passed the previous 2 semesters or 1 year and have opted for Sanskrit/Pali/Prakrit in the current class.
