Best Practice-1 – Social Conscience

Introduction

For instilling a spirit of social service in the young minds, the teachers encourage the students to apply their acquired knowledge and skills for the upliftment of lives of downtrodden and marginalized strata of the society so that the later also “receives beautiful things as ideas, openness, joy, healing and inclusion.”

In reaching out to the society in this manner, the analytic, intellectual, innovative, creative and socializing capabilities are enhanced to bring constructive and positive change in the society.

Teachers also fulfill their social responsibilities by helping the needy stakeholders.

- Teachers collectively help the needy students by donating money to bear academic expenses like fees, purchasing books, hostel dues etc.

Teachers also contribute money to help staff members and their families in the college whenever the dire need arises.

Staff Donation Fund



A Staff donation fund is generated by the staff member of the institution in which teachers contribute voluntarily to support the needy students in their academic pursuits.

A separate account in the bank is maintained for this purpose. The needy students are further verified by the college authorities, and if the case is found genuine, e.g. if any student is an orphan or is from economically weaker section irrespective of the category, is extended help out of this fund. Staff members also contribute individually towards the academic requirements of the needy students.

Even though the literacy rate in women is high, and more women are educated, but they are either unaware or are hesitant to discuss the personal health issues due to social taboos.

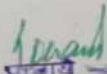
It is imperative that the young girls should be educated about personal health and hygiene, enabling them to disseminate this knowledge to other women in society to ensure that they grow in a healthy environment.

A mega Health Camp was organized by the Health & Hygiene Committee of the college in collaboration with Regional Hospital Kullu on 29-11-2023, in which 158 students and 50 teachers were benefited. In Camp, HB, Blood Sugar, BP and Eyes were checked on the spot by Dr. Susheel and Dr. Shalini along with Pharmacist Mr. Bhupinder, Health Educator Mr. Raj Kumar, Ophthalmic Officer Ms. Archana, Health Councilor Ms. Nitika and ASHA workers. ABHA registration was also part of this Programme and 250 students were registered on the spot. A special lecture was also delivered by the health Councilor Ms. Nitika on adolescence issue.

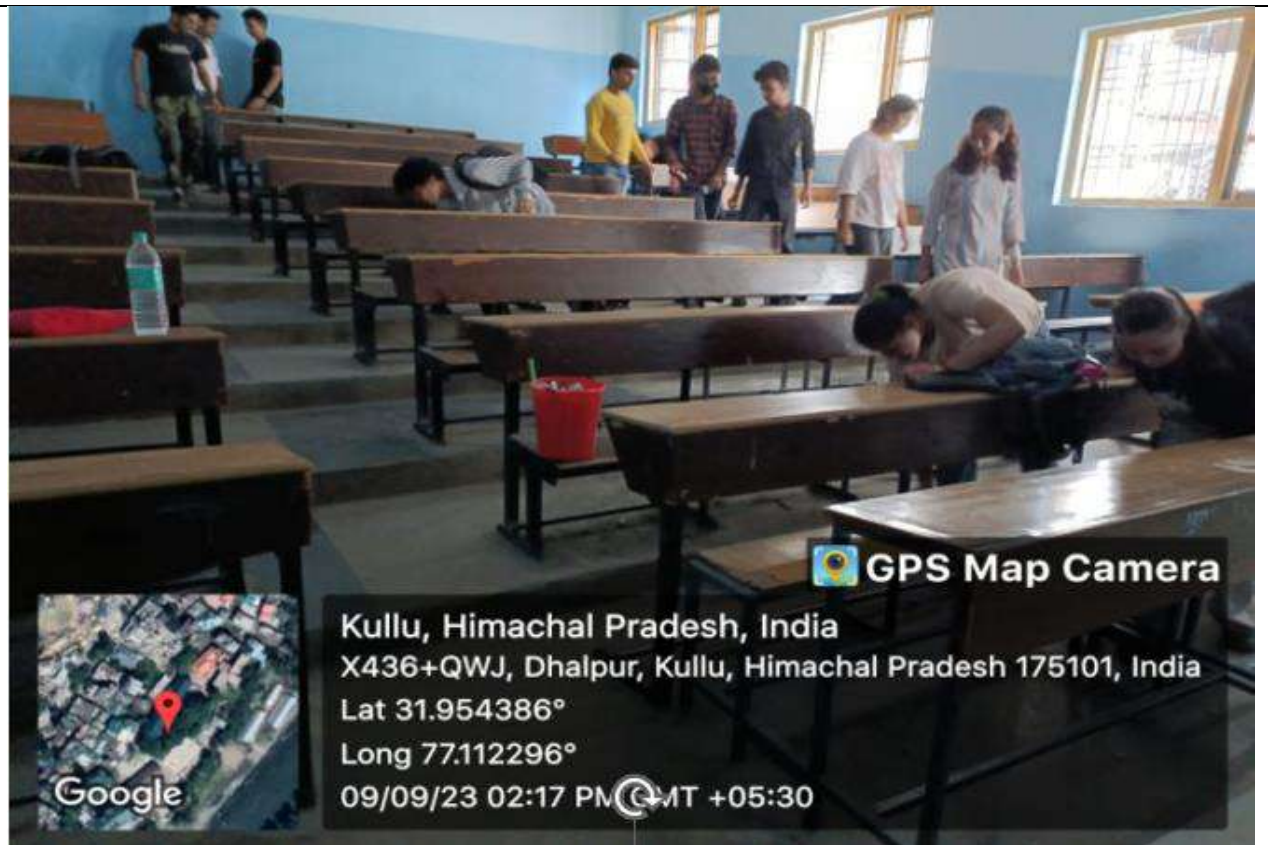

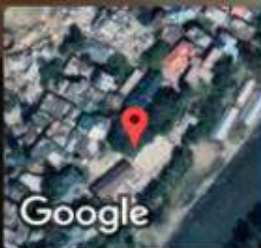

Eco friendly Campus for Environment Sustainability (Solar Energy Generation Initiative, Solid Waste Management, Rain Water Harvesting, Green Campus Initiative)

Solar Energy Initiatives

For Environmental sustainability, the college is increasingly relying on the use of non-conventional source of energy by installing Solar Photovoltaic Panels. Solar panels have been installed on the roof tops of different buildings *i.e.* Arts Block, Library Building, Boys Hostel and Science Block having capacity of 28kw, 6kw, 5kw and another 5kw respectively. **In financial year 2023-24, total 16023 units of electricity were produced through these solar panels.**

Other energy saving measures taken includes switching off electric equipment/lights when not in use and use of energy efficient LED bulbs.

Students are regularly sensitized about energy conservation by organizing lectures by HPSEB personnel that serves the objective to encourage our youth to understand the importance of energy conservation and more use of green energy.

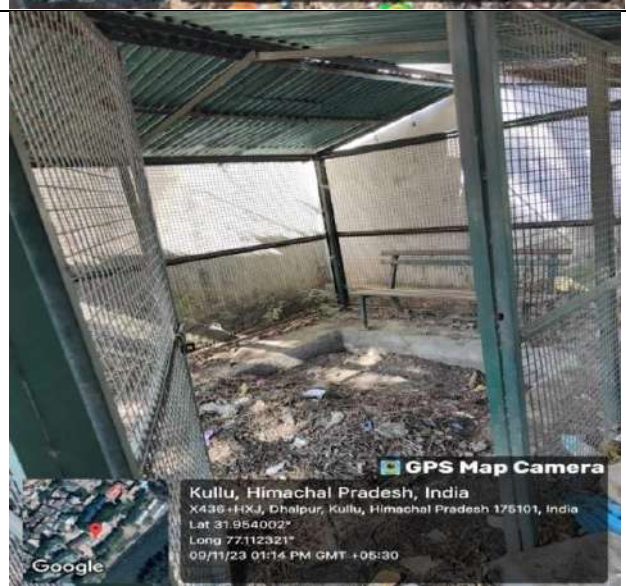

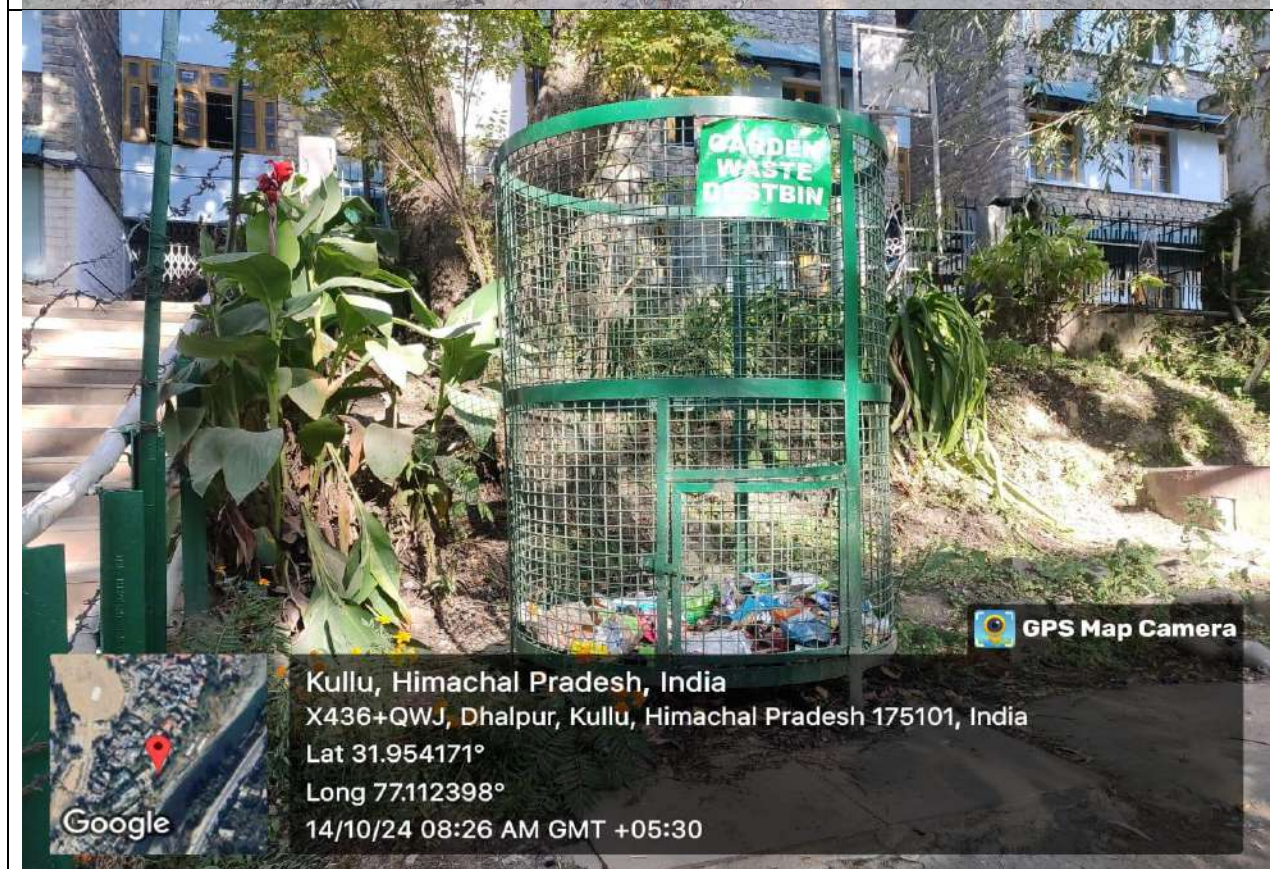
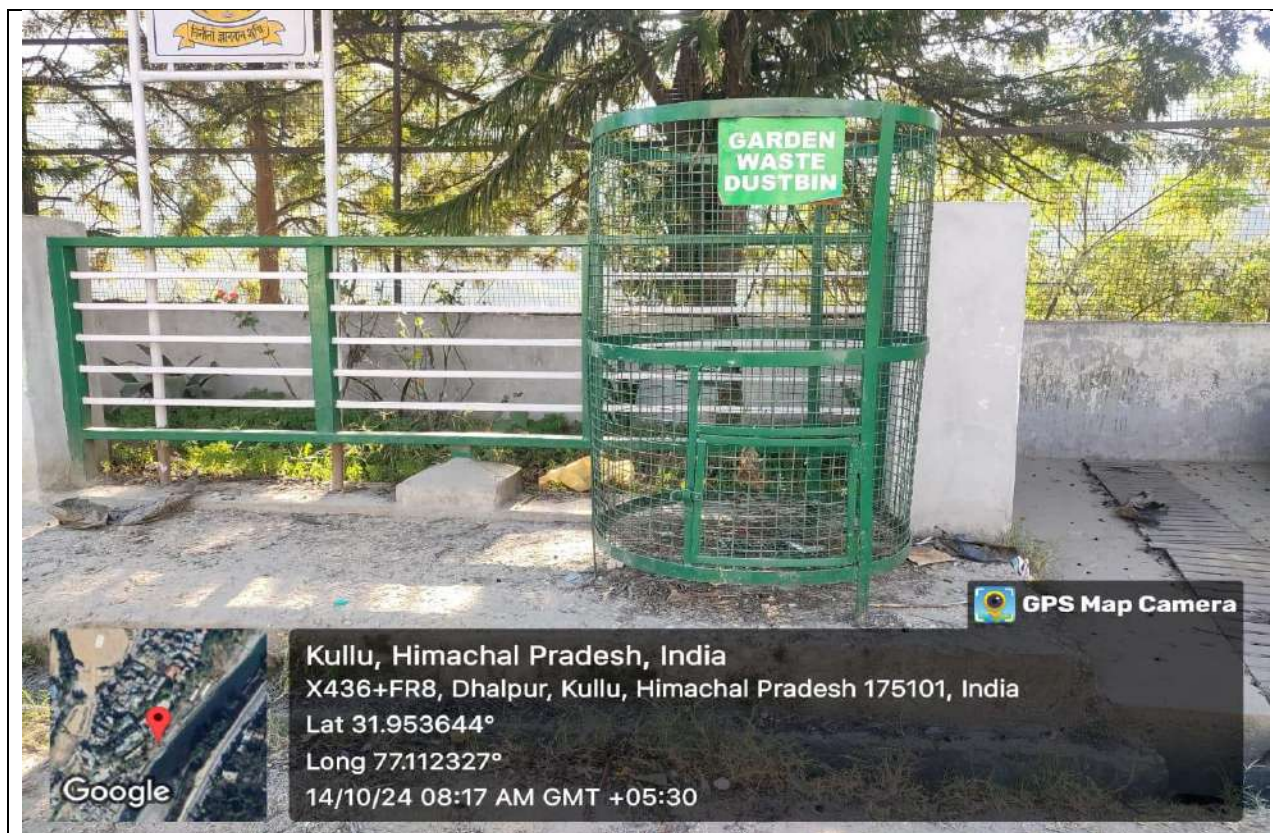

Solid Waste Collection & Segregation centre before being picked up by the Municipality Garbage Collectors in a segregated manner



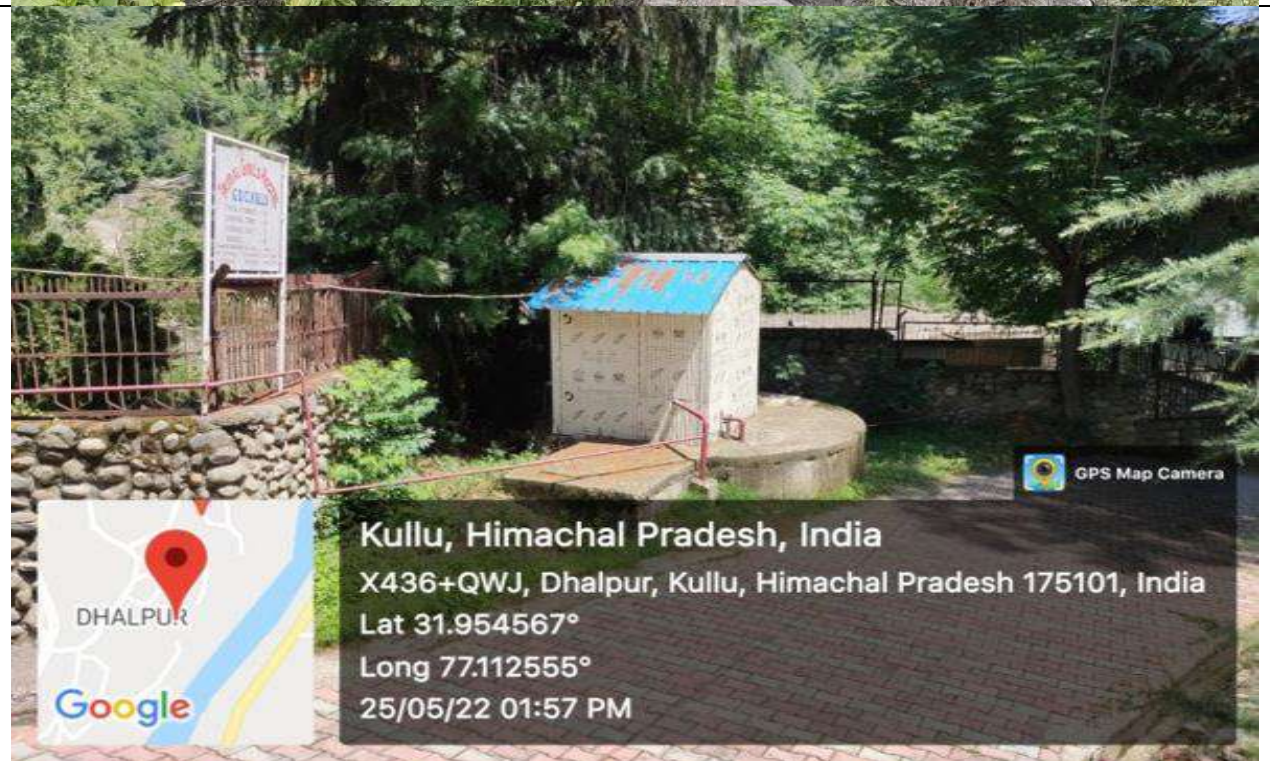
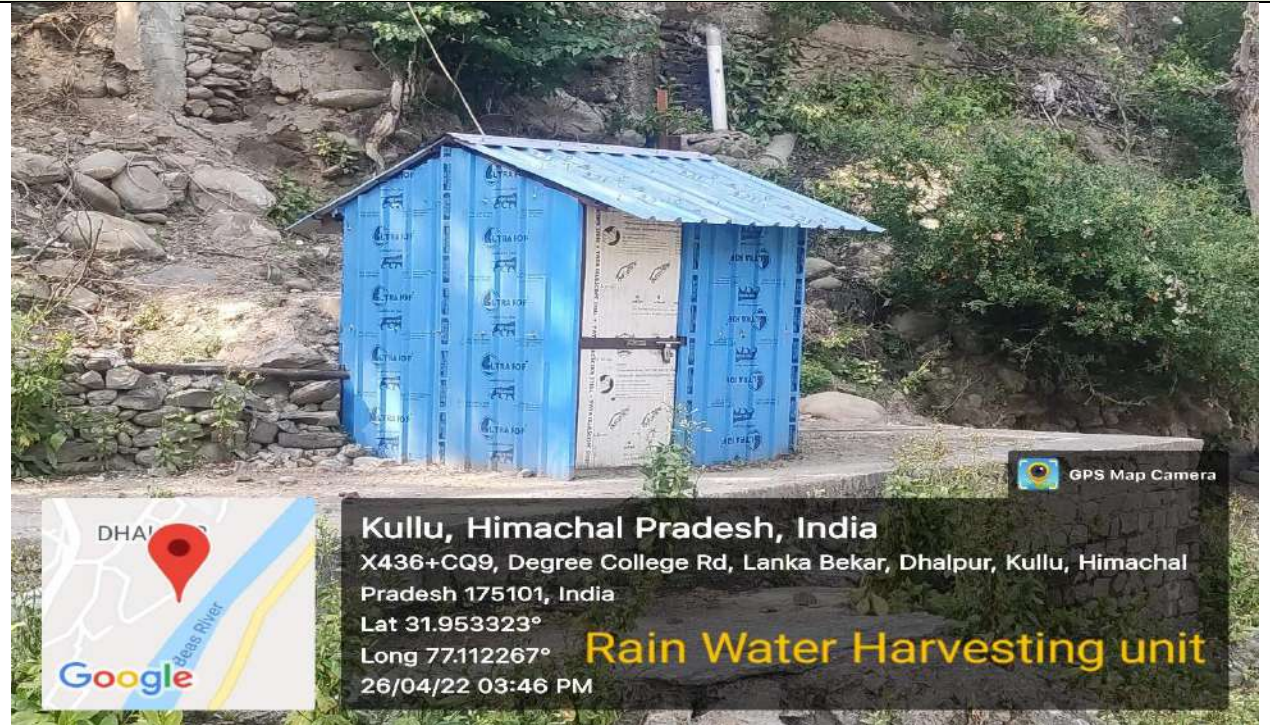






Rain Water Harvesting

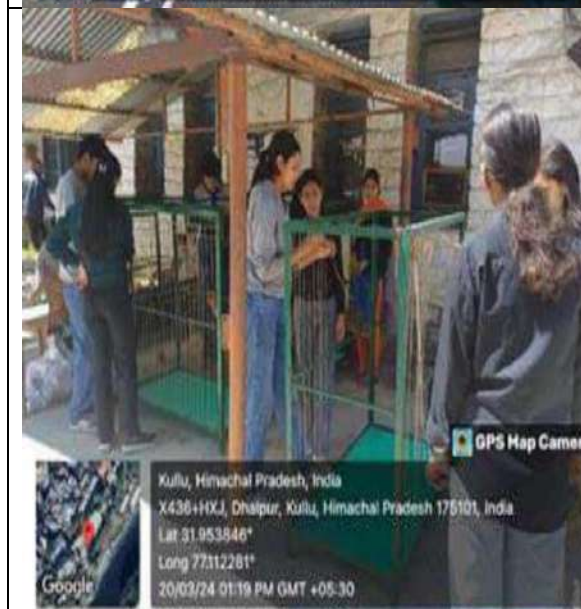
