## SEMINAR-NEP 2020

## DATED 24,25 SEPTEMBER

2020

With reference to the Directorate of Higher Education letter No. EDN-H(8)-Misc/2020 NEP 2020, dated 17 September 2020, a seminar was held in the conference Hall of GC Kullu on 24 & 25 September, 2020 in the chairmanship of Dr. N.L. Sharma, Principal GC Gadagusain Cum Charirman Task Force, in which the members of the Task Force of Principals/APs of District Kullu participated.



The objective of the seminar was to make presentations & discuss various issues and challenges related to the implementation of NEP 2020 and send certain suggestions on possible solutions to the issues pertaining to the implementation of NEP 2020.





Some of the suggestions made by the participants were:

- 1. Preferences for choosing the subjects of one's own choice should be based on availability of faculty position and infrastructure and by keeping in view the teacher student ratio.
- 2. New courses should be started only after ensuring adequate no. of the faculty and infrastructural facilities for respective courses.
- 3. Recruitment of adequate number of teachers in each and every department should be done.
- 4. To give hands on training to the students, to provide Field Based Studies and to increase job prospects, the courses as per local needs should be designed and collaboration with the local industries, other HEIs, business should be there.

- 5. There should be a provision of academic & career counseling in school as well as in colleges for enabling students to make right choices as per their aptitudes and capabilities
- 6. There should be provision of counselors to ensure physical, psychological & emotional well being of students.
- 7. For value based education references should be taken from the scriptures, lives of freedom fighter and thinkers.
- 8. Recruitment of personnel having diverse skill sets should be made for multitasking.
- 9. Orientation and Teacher Training for at least two months should be there at the entry level.
- 10. Special Research centers for preserving and reviving the regional art, culture, traditions, occupations should be established.
- 11. For thrust on internationalism and for global mobility of the Indian Students, English will have to be given place as major  $3^{rd}$  language and also as a link language in India keeping in view our country being a multilinguistic country.
- 12. Least Political Interference in Academic institution should be there.
- 13. Translations of ancient Indian Literature in modern Indian language have to be promoted.
- 14. FDPs at regular intervals for Teaching & Non Teaching staff on latest technological gadgets available should be organized.
- 15. Evaluation process should be so designed as to test one's competence, core values and temperament instead of mugged up information.
- 16. Facilities like cabins for teachers should be provided in order to promote research work
- 17. For all racting the best brains in the profession, teachers should be given incentives & financial assistance for research projects.
- 18 .Residential facilities must be provided to the college staff.
- 19. Availability of study material/text books in standard Hindi/ Regional language should be ensured.
- 20. In the undergraduate degree of 4 years, option for multidisciplinary should be given in  $4^{th}$  year only .Govt. Policy related to Research should be linked to Himachal Pradesh centric problem & issues.
