Day-1 Sunday, 29th Jan 2023 (Opening Ceremony)

The Chief guest Dr. Roshan Lal, Principal inaugurated the seven days NSS special camp on the theme "Educated Youth and Self Reliance India" on 29th January 2023. He urged the volunteers to follow the traffic rules like wearing helmets while riding two wheelers, wearing seat belts etc. to have a safe ride and also make people around them aware about it. He said that in the year 2022, 104 people lost their lives in 218 road accidents in district Kullu. Resource person told the volunteers about the different mode of cybercrimes, virus attacks, social networking security, password protection, financial fraud and its legal scenario with relevant case laws. Students were also informed about where to a file a complaint about such threats and frauds. He solved all the doubts of the volunteers very easily.



In the afternoon session, resource person **Dr. Khem Chand** NSS Nodal Officer and Assistant Professor in Govt College Panarsa, Mandi District, emphasized on the role of youth in building an ethically strong nation. He held a discussion on the theme of NSS camp 'Not Me But You' focusing the attention of the group on oneness of the universe and hence sensitising the volunteers for responsibilities towards humans and the environment. The schedule for the ensuing days was laid out and duties were assigned to the volunteers for different activities.
