Important Dates for B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Programme:

1. Submission of filled admission form complete in all respect

2. Display of 1st Merit List:

Counseling and fee deposit schedule for 1st Merit List

: 25/06/2019 at 11:00 AM

3. Display of 2nd Merit List:

: 25/06/2019 to 27/06/2019

Counseling and fee deposit schedule for 2nd Merit List : 28/06/2019 & 29/06/2019

\*Against Vacant Seats if any.

Note: Candidate failing to attend counseling or deposit the fee on the day of counseling will lose his/her claim on the seat unless she/he gives a written request to the admission committee to be Eligibility:

# For Admission in Ist Year:

A student pass in the Senior Secondary (+2) Examination (Academic Stream) conducted by the H.P Board of School Education or an examination accepted as equivalent there to by the various bodies of the H.P. University.

- Provided that the candidates, who have passed the qualifying examination i.e. 10+2 with science stream, shall be given admission to B.Sc.
- (ii) Provided that the candidates, who have passed the qualifying examination with commerce stream, shall be given preference to admission to B.Com.
- (iii) On Ist July 2019, a student should not be more than 23 years in case of boys and 25 years in case of girls in general category. Relaxation of three years will be given in case of SC/ST students as per University norms. The Vice Chancellor may permit age relaxation up to a maximum of six months for reasons to be recorded in writing.
- (iv) In each discipline, seats will be reserved for SCs, STs, Sports and Cultural quota as per HPU norms.
- (v) One seat in each department shall be reserved for single girl child which will be allotted on the basis of merit.
- (vi) Any student with compartment in +2 examination will not be eligible for admission.

Documents required at the time of admission to 1st year

⇒ 3 copies of passport size photographs.

DOB not before 1996 for Boys

⇒ Self attested copies of matriculation & 10+2 certificates.

- ⇒ Latest character certificate in original from the institute last attended. In case of private candidates latest character certificate in original by some H.P. Govt. Gazetted class-I officer.
- ⇒ Self attested copies of category certificate (SC/ST/OBC/IRDP) if claimed.
- ⇒ Selfattested copies of Sports/Cultural Activities/NCC/NSS etc. if any.
- ⇒ A certificate from competent authority in case of Single Girl Child.
- ⇒ Candidates coming from Board/University other than H.P. Board of School Education/H.P. University must produce Migration Certificate in original at the time of admission.
- ⇒ Himachali Bonafide certificate for fee concession (for girl students only)

# GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION TO BACHELOR'S DEGREE

- 1 Admission to various Main/Core subjects will be made on the recommendation of the concerned admission committee constituted for the purpose.
- 2 Gap of one year or more in the academic career of an applicant prior to seeking admission to the Bachelor Degree must be supported by documentary evidence or she/he has to give an undertaking as the proof of her/his activities during the period of gap.
- 3 The application must be filled by the candidate in her/his own handwriting. It should be complete in all respects and supported by the documents as mentioned above.
- 4 An applicant must produce original certificates before admission committee at the time of

- admission/counseling.
- 5 Applicants coming from Board /University other than the H.P. Board of School Education/H.P. University must provide Migration Certificate in original.
- 6 Handicapped applicants seeking fee concession must furnish their status certificate from Medical Board.
- 7 National Open School students seeking admission to the Ist year of Bachelor Degree must have cleared all the five papers including English.
- 8 Failed students of other institutions shall not be admitted to any class.
- 9 Admission of a candidate is liable to be cancelled in case she/he furnishes incomplete/false information or in case of concealment of facts. Disciplinary action will also be taken against such candidates.
- 10 Admission cannot be claimed as a matter of right. The Principal can deny admission to any such student whose conduct is detrimental to the interest/discipline of the institution.
- 11 Initially all admissions shall be provisional and subject to the final approval by Himachal Pradesh University.
- 12 Rules of admission are subject to change as per the H.P. University notification issued from time to time.

# Outline of the Courses Offered:

- Core Course: A course offered by a Discipline/Subject which is to be compulsorily studied by the candidate.
- (i) Discipline Specific Core Course (DSC) of six credits: A core course offered by the Discipline/Subject chosen by the candidate as main or other Discipline/Subject.
- (ii) Two papers each for English & Hindi/MIL in B.A./B.Com.
- Elective Course: A course which a student can choose from a pool of courses offered by a Discipline/Subject.
- (I) Discipline Specific Elective Course (DSE) of six credits: An elective course is a course which is chosen by a student from the courses offered by the Discipline/Subject of his/her choice.
- (ii) Generic Elective Course (GE) of six credits: A course other than DSC-I and DSC-II.

  Note:
  - Students of B.A. V and VI Semester will choose Generic Elective Courses from 1. Pol. Science 2. History 3. Economics 4. Geography 5. Hindi 6. English 7. Music 8. Sociology 9. Tour & Travel.
- Ability Enhancement Course: A course based upon the content that leads to Knowledge enhancement.
- (i) Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course (AECC) of four credits: Ability Enhancement Course which is to be compulsorily studied by the candidate. These courses include Environment Science & English/Hindi/Sanskrit.
- (ii) Ability Enhancement Elective Course (SEC/AEEC) of four credits: A course which a student studies in DSC-I (Main Subject).

# ABOUT THE BACHELOR OF VOCATION (B. Voc.) DEGREE PROGRAMME:

The University Grants Commission (UGC) has launched a scheme on skill development based job oriented higher education programme as a part of College/University education, leading to Bachelor of Vocation (B.Voc.) degree. This degree Programme is unique with the provision of multiple entry and exit at different levels of NSQF from level 5 to 7, viz. Diploma/Advance Diploma and Degree in compliance to the National Skills Qualification Framework (NSQF). Multiple entry and exit will allow students the flexibility to earn and study as per their convenience.

#### Objectives:

- To create requisite job role specific skilled manpower for industry at various NSQF levels as per NOS's (National Occupational Standards).
- To empower the youth by providing them employment and income generating opportunities.
- To provide judicious mix of skills relating to a profession and appropriate content of general education.
- To provide flexibility to the students by means of pre-defined entry and multiple exit levels.
- To integrate skill based NSQF vocational studies with the undergraduate level of higher education in order to enhance employability of the graduates and meet the industry requirements. Such graduates apart from meeting the needs of local and national industry are also expected to be competent to become part of the global workforce.

#### Course Structure:

B. Voc. programme is designed with provision for multiple exit levels. All the candidates enrolled for diploma courses or further will be treated at par from the second semester onwards. Students may exit after six months with the certificate (NSQF Level 4) or they may continue for diploma or advance diploma level courses leading to B. Voc. degree.

#### Industrial Visits:

Industrial Visits are arranged for the students of B.Voc. Retail Management as well as B.Voc. Hospitality & Tourism Management which provide the practical knowledge about the related Industries, & their management etc.

#### On Job Training (OJT):

On Job Training is an important part of the B.Voc. Course at the end of the every Level/ Semester. During the On Job Training, the students learn the working, management, job roles, co-ordination skills in an organization and also learn how to deal with various types of customers.

**HPKVN (Himachal Pradesh Kaushal Vikas Nigam)** is fully sponsoring the internship apart from facilitating the skill component (60 %) of this programme along with coursework for whole of the programme.

Candidates enrolled for this programme are entitled for 'Kaushal Vikas Bhatta' as per state government policy.

# Eligibility Conditions:

- Admission to the B. Voc. programme will be as per the rules and regulations of the Himachal Pradesh University.
- The eligibility criteria for admission to the B. Voc. degree programme shall be 10+2 in all streams from a recognized board or an examination equivalent thereof from a Board/University established by law in University/Board/College or School in a foreign country recognized as equivalent for the above Association of Indian Universities with 45% marks OR as per eligibility norms of the college for admission to undergraduate courses in case of center of excellence.
- Vocational subjects under NSQF will be given weightage, equivalent to any other general education subject while considering admission to the undergraduate courses as per reference No. DDNo.. 1-52/2013(CC/NSQF) dated 30.04.2014 of UGC.
- On 1st July 2019, a student should not be more than 23 years in case of boys and 25 years in case of girls in general category. Relaxation in case of SC/ST will be given as per university norms. The Vice-Chancellor may permit age relaxation up to a maximum of six months for reasons to be recorded in writing.
- Reservation rules are applicable as per the rules or guidelines of the Himachal Pradesh Government.
- ♦ Students belonging to SC/ST category shall be given a 5% relaxation in marks for admission purpose, i.e., they would require a minimum of 40% marks in aggregate at 10+2 level.
- ♦ Students having compartment shall not be allowed admission in the B.Voc. programmes.
- ♦ A candidate cannot pursue two full time undergraduate courses simultaneously.
- ♦ The University reserves the right to cancel any admission at any stage.
- In matters relating to undergraduate admissions, the decision of the Admission Committee/Vice-Chancellor, Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla, shall be final.
- ♦ All legal matters pertaining to undergraduate admissions shall be subject to the Himachal Pradesh jurisdiction only.
- ♦ Admission to the B.Voc. programme in Retail Management and Hospitality & Tourism (Semester-I) shall be done purely on the merit in the qualifying examination (10+2 etc.).
- ♦ There are three categories of candidates who shall be given admission in Semester-I of the skill-based courses under NSQF.
  - Category 1: Students who have already acquired NSQF certification Level 4 in a particular Industry sector may opt for admission in the skill-based courses under NSQF.
  - Category 2: Students who have acquired NSQF certification Level 4, but may like to change their trade and enter into skill-based courses in a different trade.
  - Category 3: Students who have passed the 10+2 examination with conventional schooling without any background of vocational training.

Note: Regarding selection of students for B.Voc. programme, 10% extra weightage shall be given to Category-1 and 5% extra weightage shall be given to Category-2 in 10+2 examination. Final list of students shall be decided on merit.

The course content of the B.Voc. programme will be taught in English.

- Disabled students with more than 40% disability will be exempted of tuition fee subject to the production of disability Certificate issued by the competent medical Authority at the time of admission.

### Guidelines for Admission to M.A. Courses:

#### General Rules:

The admission will be on the basis of centralized entrance tests conducted by the HPU for the session 2019-20. The students interested in admission to the institution, will have to apply separately after the declaration of results by the HPU. The final list of candidates will be decided on merit.

An applicant should not be more than 26 years of age as on 1-7-2019 in case of boys & 28 years in case of girls. The upper age limit is 29 years for SC/ST applicants. The Vice-Chancellor may permit age relaxation up to a maximum of 6 months for reasons to be recorded in writing.

- A candidate who fails in 1<sup>st</sup> semester may be permitted to join 2<sup>nd</sup> semester but she/he shall not be permitted to proceed from 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> semester without appearing in 2<sup>nd</sup> semester examination.
- 2 15% and 7.5% reservation is available to SC and ST applicants respectively. In case the reserved seats remain vacant, the same shall be considered open for the general category applicants.
- 3 The admission of a student migrating from another university shall be treated as provisional and shall be confirmed only on the production of migration certificate and character certificate in original from Head of the Institution last attended.

**Note:** The eligible candidate who has passed Honours course in English/Economics/Pol.

Science will be given weightage as per the HP University norms.

# **Eligibility Conditions:**

Candidates who have passed Bachelor's Degree examination with at least 50% marks in aggregate or 45% marks or Honours in English/Economics/Pol. Science are eligible. Relaxation of 5% marks in minimum eligibility for admission will be given to SC/ST candidates.

# Procedure of Admission:

- 1 The candidate should fill the admission form in her/his own handwriting and submit it to the admission committee. The admission form must be complete in all respects.
- 2 A candidate seeking admission to first year of any course must appear before the concerned admission committee with her/his parents or guardian.
- 3 A candidate seeking admission to any class should appear before the concerned admission committee, thereafter the Chief Convener of the Faculty concerned.
- 4 When admission is granted to a candidate, the candidate must deposit fees within a day failing which her/his admission will stand cancelled.
- 5 At the time of appearing before admission committee, the applicant should submit her/his application form complete in all respects with other documents in the sequence given below:
  - (i) Admission Form
  - (ii) Library Registration Form
  - (iii) Character Certificate in original
  - (iv) Attested copies of Matriculation, 10+2 certificate & attested copy of Bachelor Degree Certificate.
  - (v) Attested copy of H.P.U. Registration card (if any).

If two male wards of the same parent are getting education in the college, only one will be eligible for the scholarship.

Fee concession will be given to the poor but brilliant students on the recommendation of fee concession committee. If two brothers are studying in the college, only senior one will be considered for the concession.

The scholarships are awarded to the students as per norms and rules prescribed by the department. The students will have to apply for scholarship through internet on *hp epass website*, the dates for which will be notified on College Notice Boards. Only those students who are regular in the college rolls (her/his name should not be struck off from the college roll and should have atleast 75% lecture attendance) and have obtained minimum passing marks in all subjects in the house examination are eligible for the award of scholarship/concession.

#### Fines and Penalties

- Failure to pay dues on/by due date will entail a fine of ₹5 per day.
- The name of student shall be struck off from the college roll, if she/he remains absent without sanctioned leave for

- continuous 10 days or more than 10 days in a month.
- 3. Re admission is permissible with a fine of ₹3100/- for the first time and ₹200/- for the second time on the recommendation of concerned teacher.
- For seeking re-admission the candidate must be accompanied by her/his parent or guardian.
- 5. If a student fails to seek re-admission within 7 days after his/her name is struck off, he/she will have to pay additional fine @ ₹10/- per day for a maximum upto 10 days at the time of readmission. After this period the student will lose her/his right to re-admission.
- The Principal can expel/rusticate a student from the college if found guilty of misconduct.
- The library security deposit will lapse if a student doesn't apply for refund within 1 year of her/his leaving the college.
- 8. A fine of ₹100/- shall be imposed on a student if she/he is found using cell phone in college campus except cell phone zone i.e. playground of college. Repeated offence will lead to increase in fine and even confiscating of cell phone.
- A fine of ₹500/- shall be imposed on a student carrying intoxicants/smoking materials within the campus.
- A student without college identity card in the college campus will be imposed a fine of ₹50.

#### Other fines will be as given below:

- a) Absence per period: ₹1/-
- b) Absence per practical: ₹3/-
- c) Absence in Minor Test: ₹100 per paper
- d) Delay in returning Library books: ₹1/per day per volume.

Note: Students are advised to preserve fee receipt issued by the college for future use. In case fee receipt is lost, photocopy/Fee Receipt No. of the same can be obtained from the clerk on the payment of ₹100/-.

# Anti-ragging Regulations and Zero Tolerance to Ragging

Ragging according to the Honorable Supreme Court of India judgment/order 2001 is defined as "any Ragging according to the Honorable Supreme Court of the Supreme Court of the Honorable Suprem disorderly conduct whether by words spoken of writes or indiscipline activities which causes or is handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or indiscipline activities which causes or is handling with rudeness any other student, industrial and or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological hards of the student of the fresher or a junior student or asking the students to do any the student or a junior student or a sking the student will not do in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or will not do in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student."

Any student found indulged in above stated activities or ragging in any form whatsoever will be

punished appropriately which may include:

- 1. Withholding scholarship or other benefits.
- Debarring from representation of college events.
- 3. Withholding of results.
- Suspension or expulsion from hostel, mess and college.
- 5. Initiation of legal proceedings under criminal law.
- Fine up to ₹25000/- with public apology.
- 7. In case of more serious allegations, FIR will be lodged against such offenders with police and matter will be disposed of in the court of law where if convicted for such an offence, the offender can be punished with imprisonment up to three years or fine up to ₹50,000 or both. Such an offender will stand expelled from the institution and will not be eligible for admission in any other institution for a period of three years.

In case a victim student does not know the name of offending students she/he can give complaint in writing and identify such offenders and an action as specified above can be initiated against them. Note: In case of any incidence of ragging please contact any of the following immediately:
