📄 Subject Selection Pattern

During the **First Year**, students shall study:

- **Three discipline-specific subjects from the same stream/faculty**
- **SEC** – Skill Enhancement Courses
- **AEC** – Ability Enhancement Courses
- **MDC** – Multidisciplinary Course
- **VAC** – Value Added Courses

Subject combinations shall be offered subject to the availability of faculty, classrooms, and the institutional timetable

Choice of Major and Minor Subjects

At the end of the Second Semester, students shall choose:

- **Major Subject** – Main discipline of specialisation
- **Minor Subject** – Supporting or complementary discipline

Students may also opt for courses from other disciplines to broaden their academic exposure and interdisciplinary understanding.

Types of Courses Under NEP 2020

Course Type

Purpose / Description

Major Courses

Main discipline chosen by the student for specialization and advanced learning.

Minor Courses

Supporting discipline studied along with the Major subject.

DSC (Discipline Specific Core)

Provides core and foundational subject knowledge.

DSE (Discipline Specific Electives)

Offers specialised and elective-based learning within the discipline.

MDC (Multidisciplinary Courses)

Courses from disciplines other than the Major/Minor to promote multidisciplinary learning.

SEC (Skill Enhancement Courses)

Skill-oriented and practical courses aimed at enhancing employability and professional competence.

AEC (Ability Enhancement Courses)

Courses related to language proficiency, communication, and soft skills development.

VAC (Value Addition Courses)

Courses focusing on ethics, values, personality development, and holistic education.

Internship / Project / Community Engagement

Practical exposure through internships, field work, surveys, projects, and community participation.
